1. Background

1.1 Davyhulme Park Golf Club, is located on Gleneagles Road in Urmston and is a company run members golf club which has existed at the location since September 1923.

The Premises currently benefits from premises licence PL000579 (**Appendix B**).





- 2. Application for the Grant of a Variation to Premises Licence (PL000579)
- On 29th July, 2016 the Licensing Section received an application (Appendix A) from Mr Keith Melia, General Manager, on behalf of Davyhulme Park Golf Club Limited who own the premises.
- **2.2** The application requests the granting of a major variation to the existing premises licence (**Appendix B**) to increase the Supply of Alcohol on the premises on Sunday's only.
- 2.3 The application requests the change of the licensable activity for Sale of Alcohol (on the premises) as follows:

Sale of Alcohol (on the premises):

Existing - Sunday : Noon -22:30Application - Sunday : 10:00 - 23:30

- **2.4** All other hours and conditions remain the same.
- 2.5 The applicant has complied with all requirements under the application process including advertising the application in a newspaper, advertising by way of public notice at the premises and submitting a copy of the complete application to all Responsible Authorities. The application is deemed to be correctly submitted.

3. Representations



- 3.1 During the consultation period, representations were received from local residents (Appendix C 1 to 5).
- 3.2 The Committee are respectfully advised that the representations received against the application broadly relate to the Licensing Objectives:
 - Prevention of Public Nuisance
 - Prevention of Crime and Disorder
- 3.3 The Members are advised that The Government's Guidance states that it is not sufficient for an objector to simply state that they wish to object, or that they are objecting on noise grounds. A representation should give more detail of the likely impact should the licence be granted.
- 3.4 It is recommended that, in borderline cases, the benefit of the doubt about any aspect of a representation should be given to the person making that

- representation. The subsequent hearing would then provide an opportunity for the person or body making the representation to amplify and clarify it.
- **3.7** The Members are therefore required to determine the relevance of all representations.
- 3.8 When considering the relevance of any representation the Licensing Sub-Committee must be aware that :
 - il the representation can be from any person or body;
 - ii. it must not be repetitious, vexatious or frivolous:
 - it must relate to one or more of the licensing objectives.

4. Licensing Policy and Guidance

4.1 The Committee are respectfully referred to the Council's own Licensing Policy relating to the Licensing Act 2003 objectives and to the Secretary of State's Guidance. (Copy available at meeting)

5. Options

- 5.1 The Sub-Committee to take such steps as they consider necessary for the promotion of the Licensing Objectives in accordance with the provisions of subsection (4) of the Licensing Act 2003. The steps specified are:
 - **5.1.1** To grant the licence subject to-
 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule accompanying the application modified to such extent as the authority considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives, and;
 - Any mandatory conditions which must be included under the Licensing Act 2003
 - **5.1.2** to exclude from the scope of the licence any of the licensable activities to which the application relates;
 - **5.1.3** to refuse to specify a person in the licence as the premises supervisor:
 - **5.1.4** to reject the application.
- 5.2 The Sub-Committee is advised that any findings on any issues of fact should be on the balance of probability and any decision should be based on the individual merits of the application.
- 5.3 The Sub-Committee, in arriving at its decision, must have regard to relevant provisions of national guidance and its own statement of licensing policy and reasons should be given for any departure.







We would like to ask the question: - If this were a members event would they allow such behavior especially when it affects their local neighborhood and compromises the good name that they once held with all residents.

We do of course realise that in the modern world their golf club is required to look into alternative forms of income, and we feel that the residents have been very receptive to that, however the thought of our peaceful Sunday's being totally disrupted on top of enduring their regular weekend noise levels and disruption until the early hours of the evening is just totally inacceptable, and we therefore **object most strongly**

I wish to make representation in relation to the above, briefly outlined below:-

The application states that the club would like to extend there licence to allow Regulated Entertainment including Singing, Dancing, Live Performers, Playing of Recorded Music etc. and serve alcohol generally throughout the day up 23:30hrs on a Sunday evening.

My concern is that this extends the existing license time in the evening on a Sunday from 22:30hrs. to 23:30hrs.

The majority of the local residents have to go to work or attend to family commitments on a Monday morning from around 07:00hrs. Given that most licensed premises can take up to an hour (or more) to be cleared of people which could bring the time to around 00:30hrs. effectively the next day. Giving rise to the noise of people and traffic leaving the premises when the majority of local residents, some with young children are trying to get to sleep.

The Golf Club already has the facility for late venues on Friday and Saturday nights please spare the local residents from typically the strains of an out of tune rendition of "New York, New York" on a Sunday evening/Monday morning as well as the already licensed Friday and Saturday evenings.

Whilst appreciating we are fortunate to live in a good location facing a very nice golf club, quite frankly 11:30hrs is just too late on a Sunday for these proposals in a quiet residential area.
