<u>Longford Park National Lottery Heritage Fund Development Phase Bid</u>		
That submission of the Longford Park National Lottery Heritage Fund Development Phase bid, be approved.		
<u>REASONS FOR THE DECISION</u>		
Following the success of the Council's formal expression of interest (EOI) for National Lottery Heritage Funding, approval to submit a development phase application (often referred to as a 'stage one' bid) is needed to allow the Council to continue to compete for funding.		
<u>ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED AND REJECTED AT THE MEETING/BY MEMBERS</u>		
Not submitting the bid would risk the further deterioration of the built and landscape heritage of Trafford's largest and strategically most important urban park, whilst also missing the opportunity to realise Longford Park's potential to provide multiple environmental, social and economic benefits for Trafford.
