#### RECORD OF THE DECISION

### COVID 19 Council Tax Hardship Fund 2020-21

- (1) That Trafford Council:
  - Awards all existing working age Council Tax Support (CTS) recipients as at
    11 March 2020 a discretionary award equivalent to the value of their 2020-21 liability;
  - Treat all new, post 11 March 2020, claims in accordance with its existing CTS scheme, as the vast majority of recipients will receive 100% support, but ensure direct information and advice for further discretionary support is detailed in notification letters;
  - Use the remaining funding towards the rising costs of CTS claims made after 11 March 2020 and significantly increasing Local Welfare Assistance costs.
- (2) That this decision be classified as urgent and exempt from call-in to enable the Council implement emergency measures during the ongoing Covid-19 health crisis.

#### REASONS FOR THE DECISION

To determine how the Council will award the Council Tax element of the government award to support economically vulnerable people and households during the COVID-19 crisis, using the discretionary powers under Section 13A (1) (c) of the Local Government Finance Act 1992 and also how the remainder will be used to support vulnerable residents.
