## Aldi, School Road, Sale, M33 7XY Full Variation Application received by the Licensing Authority

I write to you as a lifelong School Road resident, we live directly opposite the Aldi Store on School Road and wish to object in the strongest possible terms to the variation to the Licence. The proposed increase in operating times, would cause great disruption to us and to all local residents, there are fourteen residential properties in the immediate vicinity of the Aldi Store.

The noise of the opening and closing of the store alone is already disruptive at the present within the existing operating times, the noise of the iron shutters and staff voices being a particular nuisance at unsociable hours.

The sale of alcohol, particularly until midnight, will add to the anti-social behaviour problems in this locality. There is the problem that the later hours would exasperate the trouble with people coming out of the pubs and using the store to purchase further alcohol, which is often consumed outside the store on the public highway – a cause of much anti-social behaviour.

The issue of aggressive beggars outside this particular store is an issue that has been ongoing for over four years – the associated anti-social behaviour has been reported to the police and Trafford Council, Cllr Barry Brotherton and former Cllr. Brian Rigby have been heavily involved in trying to resolve the issue, so far without success.

I can only appeal to the Licensing Authority to refuse this application, as increased hours of operation would be complete disaster to local residents.
