

## Position statement from Youth Engagement Service on the Proposal from Boys and Girls Clubs of Greater Manchester to take over the lease of the old Partington Youth Centre on Moss Lane in Partington March 2021

Partington is an area of high deprivation and limited transport links which mean that young people in the town have limited access to affordable engagement activities. Youth work delivered in the borough pre and post pandemic includes (but is not limited to):

- Screamin Wheels a volunteer led community youth work organisation with 20 years' experience of delivering youth clubs, most recently at Moss View Primary School (which is no longer available for use). Youth clubs run by Screamin Wheels were regularly accessed by 50-100 young people a week.
- Junior Youth club (9-11 year olds) run by volunteers Nicole Hall and Tamsin
  Allen with up to 50 young people a week who were using the Fuse, funded via a
  short term grant. The Junior Youth club ceased due to high cost of the Fuse and
  the external funding finishing.
- Street Talk detached Youth Work delivered by the Youth Engagement Service.
   Partington regularly attracts some of the highest take up of young people to engage with on the streets for the Council's detached youth work teams.

BGCGM deliver Youth Centre activities in a number of other locations including Wythenshawe in South Manchester so have experience of setting up and running equivalent services. As part of their proposal BGCGM have conducted surveys to gather views of over 200 young people in the local community and have engaged with volunteers running Screamin Wheels and the Junior Youth club. They proposal will provide premises for youth groups to run 4 or 5 nights a week. BGCGM have held provisional discussions with YES managers as the Street Talk team would benefit from providing centre based activities during the dark, cold and wet winter nights in partnership with existing groups. BGCGM want to work with Screamin Wheels and other partners to redevelop both the centre, the skate park and the outside space. The building is currently in need of complete modernisation and is currently not in a fit state for use (according to a published survey report). BGCGM are proposing to spend £500K (as the estimated cost to modernise the building).

The Youth Engagement Management team has discussed the proposals and are strongly in favour for the following reasons:

1. Partington is an area of high deprivation with poor transport links, young people in the area are often unable to afford alternative activities. Take up of youth work activities and clubs has always been exceptionally high (comparatively higher than in any other areas of the borough).

- 2. The local community, children and young people have been consulted and are involved in the plans including volunteers from Screamin Wheels and the Junior Youth club.
- 3. Both Screamin Wheels and the Junior Youth club do not currently have access or funding to use alternative accommodation.
- 4. Initial discussions with BGCGM CEO and the YES service manager have in principal agreed that the centre can be used to deliver youth work activities (in partnership with community groups) when the weather is not conducive to successful street based work in the winter months.
- 5. BGCGM are open to other activities that could be delivered from the centre which may include NEET delivery (Partington has the highest NEET rate in the borough).
- 6. BGCGM can be part of the Trafford Team Together initiative as a key partner in the delivery of locality services.

In short the proposal is in the right place, with the right community partners, targeted at the right children and young people.
