1. Application for the Grant of a Premises Licence.

1.1 On the 22nd May, 2015 the Licensing Section received an application from London Midland Railway Club Association, for the grant of a premises licence for London Midland Railway Club Association, 127 Navigation Road, Timperley, Altrincham. (**Appendix A**).

1.2 The application requested the granting of a premises licence to provide sale of alcohol (on & off) the premises, late night refreshment and regulated entertainment.

1.3 The hours requested for the licensable activities on the original application are as follows:

Sale of Alcohol (on & off premises):
Monday to Sunday – 10:00 to 02:00

Late Night Refreshment (indoors & outdoors):
Monday to Sunday – 23:00 to 02:00

Provision of Regulated Entertainment (plays; films; indoor sports; boxing or wrestling, live music; recorded music; and performance of dance):

Monday to Sunday – 11:00 to 02:00

1.4 The applicant has complied with all requirements under the application process including advertising the application in a newspaper, advertising by way of public notice at the premises and submitting a copy of the complete application to all Responsible Authorities. The application is deemed to be correctly submitted.

2. Representations

2.1 During the consultation period, a representation was received from the Council's Pollution Section (**Appendix B**).

2.2 The recommended conditions have been agreed by the applicant and will form part of the proposed conditions to be attached to the premises licence (**Appendix B**).

3. Options

The Members are invited to consider the representation and the agreement given by the applicant and either:

- Agree that a hearing is not necessary and determine to grant the licence subject to the conditions being attached; or
 - Agree that a hearing is necessary with all the parties present.

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 9)

WE HAVE AN ANNUAL FIRE EQUIPMENT SERVICE CHECK TO ENSURE ALL EXTINGUISHERS ARE IN DATE AND THE CORRECT TYPE. HEALTH AND SAFETY RECORDS ARE KEPT, WEEKLY FIRE ALARM TESTS ARE CARRIED OUT, ACCIDENT BOOK IS MAINTAINED UP TO DATE. THE CLUB HAS A RISK ASSESSMENT DOCUMENT WHICH IS AGAIN KEPT UP TO DATE. CLEAR FIRE EXIT SIGNS ARE POSTED ABOUT THE CLUB AS WELL AS THE ASSEMBLY POINTS. THERE IS A GUEST BOOK FOR GUESTS TO SIGN IN WHO USE THE LOUNGE AND GAMES ROOM. ANY GUEST MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A MEMBER.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

THE CLUBS OPENING TIMES ARE DISPLAYED OUTSIDE THE CLUB. THERE IS NO CCTV OUTSIDE THE CLUB ALTHOUGH I BELIEVE THE METRO DOES HAVE THEM COVERING THEIR CAR PARK AREAS. THE CLUB DOES HAVE BAR CCTV IN OPERATION. RECORDINGS ARE KEPT FOR A LIMITED TIME BY THE CLUB SECRETARY.

c) Public safety

THE CLUB KEEPS A RECORD AND DISPLAYS CURRENT FIRE CERTIFICATES. FIRE EXITS ARE DISPLAYED WITHIN ALL AREAS OF THE CLUB ALONG WITH ASSEMBLY POINTS. HEATING, ELECTRICAL VENTILATION AND SANITARY EQUIPMENT IS MAINTAINED IN GOOD ORDER.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

THE CLUB HAS NOTICES FOR CUSTOMERS LEAVING THE PREMISES TO RESPECT THE NEEDS OF NEARBY RESIDENTS. DELIVERIES ARE USUALLY DONE DURING THE DAY. CUSTOMERS ARE ASKED NOT TO STAND AROUND TALKING IN THE STREET OUTSIDE THE PREMISES. THE MOVEMENT OF BINS, INCLUDING BOTTLE BINS IS USUALLY DONE BETWEEN 16:00 HOURS AND 18:00 HOURS TO REDUCE THE LEVELS OF NOISE PRODUCED BY THE PREMISES. THE OUTSIDE OF THE CLUB HAS BRIGHT LIGHTS WHICH ARE ON THE METROLINK CAR PARK TO WHICH THE CLUB IS NEXT TO.

e) The protection of children from harm

THE CLUB OPERATES A "CHALLENGE 25" POLICY. ALL STAFF HAVE TO UNDERGO A TRAINING COURSE AND SIGN THE REGISTER TO CONFIRM THEIR TRAINING. OUR "CHALLENGE 25" COVERS AREAS FOR CORRECT TYPE OF ID. WE HAVE A REFUSAL LOG FOR STAFF TO ENTER DETAILS SHOULD SOMEONE BE REFUSED TO BE SERVED. WE HAVE "CHALLENGE 25" NOTICES ABOUT THE CLUB. THE CLUB DOES NOT ACCEPT ANY BOOKING FOR ANY 18TH CELEBRATIONS. WE ARE A CLUB THAT TAKES THE PREVENTION OF HARM TO CHILDREN VERY SERIOUSLY AND TO ENSURE THAT WE ARE FULLY COMPLIANT TO STOP PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS TRYING TO OBTAIN ALCOHOL.
