RECORD OF THE DECISION

Approval for a Trial of Personal Delivery Devices (PDDs) to Operate in an Area of Trafford

- 1. That a 3-month trial of the use of 'Personal Delivery Devices' or 'PDDs' in areas of Broadheath, West Timperley, Sale West and Ashton upon Mersey, be approved.
- 2. That the Corporate Director of Place be delegated authority to agree and finalise the operating agreement.
