RECORD OF THE DECISION

Ashover Street, Gorse Hill, Stretford : Proposed Disabled Persons' Permit Parking Bays - Consideration of Objections

2. That, following careful consideration of the objections received and the recommendations of the One Stop Resource Centre, authorisation be given to make and introduce the Traffic Regulation Order, as advertised, and as shown on the plan appended to the report.
