RECORD OF THE DECISION

Elton Street, Stretford - Proposal to introduce a new Disabled Residents' Permit Parking Space: Consideration of objections and proposal to introduce a 2nd Disabled Residents' Permit Bay

1. That the introduction of a disabled residents' permit parking space on Elton Street, Stretford be approved.
2. That, following careful consideration of the objection received, authorisation be given to make and introduce the Traffic Regulation Order, as advertised.
3. That the objector be notified of the Council's decision.
4. That the introduction of a second disabled residents' permit parking space on Elton Street, Stretford be approved.
5. That authorisation be given to advertise the intention of making the Traffic Regulation Order referred to in schedule 3 to this report and, if no objections are maintained, that the Order be made and the proposal implemented.
6. That a consultation be carried out with nearby residents.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

To enable the necessary parking restrictions to be introduced and enforced and to enhance resident amenity.
