RESOLVED: That the minutes of the Public Protection Sub-Committee meeting held on 21st July 2016 be agreed as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

10. REQUEST FOR REVIEW OF VEHICLE LICENCE CONDITION - VEHICLE **IDENTIFICATION PLATE**

The Head of Regulatory Services submitted a report requesting Members to consider a request from a private hire vehicle proprietor to review the Council's current condition relating to the fixing of identification plates to licensed vehicles.

Representations were made by Mr. Morgan, PMJ Travel.

RESOLVED: That the current condition be amended to read as follows:

The identification platform must be securely fixed to the rear outer most part of the vehicle's bodywork, to the satisfaction of an authorised officer. The fixing of plates on the front or rear windshield is not allowed.

The plate must be affixed to the platform by means of the fixing devices supplied by the Council. The plate must be clearly visible to the driver of a following vehicle, and it must be capable of being easily removed by an authorised officer or a constable. The plate shall be so affixed to the vehicle, by the proprietor at his own expense.

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11. HACKNEY CARRIAGE UNMET DEMAND STUDY 2015

The Head of Regulatory Services submitted a report requesting members to consider the findings of a study conducted on behalf of the Council in to the demand for hackney carriage services in Trafford.

Representations were made by several members of the taxi trade.

RESOLVED: That the recommendation of the survey be accepted and the current limit of 143 vehicle licences be maintained.

The Head of Regulatory Services submitted a report requesting Members to consider an application for the grant of a Private Hire driver's licence.

The applicant attended the meeting to enable Members to give the matter their full consideration.

The applicant provided the Sub-Committee with a brief outline of what he said were the circumstances of the offence.

The applicant also answered questions directed to him from Sub-Committee Members.

RESOLVED: That Mr. U. R's application for a Private Hire driver's licence be granted.

14. PRIVATE HIRE DRIVER'S LICENCE

The Head of Regulatory Services submitted a report requesting Members to consider whether to renew a Private Hire driver's licence.

The driver's representative explained the events.

The driver answered questions from the Sub-Committee.

The Sub-Committee noted that there have been 3 allegations/incidents of a sexual nature made against the driver over a 4 ½ year period. Each allegation(s) taken individually or collectively are serious in their own right and the frequency of the allegations could not be ignored.

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It was also noted that the allegations were made by 3 different complainants who were not related to each other and the allegations were of a similar nature. The Sub-Committee's view was that there was a lack of detail provided by the driver as to his account of these 3 matters.

In relation to his conviction for plying for hire, it was determined that his explanation was not plausible, insofar as he stated that the passengers got into his vehicle off their own volition despite him telling them that they were not allowed to. This conviction in its own right is also considered to be a significant factor in the Sub-Committee reaching its decision.

RESOLVED: That Mr. Y. Z was not a fit and proper person to hold a Private Hire driver's licence

1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 The contract to test all Trafford hackney carriage and private hire vehicles is currently undertaken by Essential Fleet Services at the Council's Higher Road Depot in Urmston. This contract is due to expire on the 8th January 2017.
- 1.2 In July 2016 the Council's Licensing Section engaged the services of STAR Procurement to oversee the process of awarding a new contract.
- 1.3 It was agreed that the appropriate route to market would be via an invitation to tender process, as this will be a concession based contract with an estimated value of £500,000.00
- 1.4 The agreed timeline for awarding the contract is as follows:

Issue of Invitation to Tender Submission of Tender Evaluation of Tender Recommendation to Award Award of Contract Standstill period (Alcatel) Final Award Contract commencement 3rd October 2016 4th November 2016 7th – 11th November 2016 14th November 2016 21st November 2016 Midnight on the 5th December 2016 6th December 2016 1st February 2017

- 1.5 Should Essential Fleet Services be unsuccessful then the current contract will be extended from the 9th January until the 1st February 2017 to allow a handover of existing bookings and staff to the new provider.
- 1.6 The contract has been advertised on the Chest portal and stakeholders have been notified. Please see attached invitation to tender notice.
- 1.7 The award of the contract is being managed by STAR Procurement and all questions and answers relating to the process will be dealt with by them through the portal.
- 1.8 In terms of the contract specification, the successful Contractor must demonstrate that they can carry out the testing of vehicles in an efficient and cost effective manner; have innovative and flexible ways of dealing with requests for service; and will be able to deal with the expected increase in demand over the next three years. In this way the new contract should ensure competitive pricing coupled with a quality service for both the hackney carriage and private hire trades.
- 1.9 The contract will be awarded for three years with an option to extend for a further two years.
- 1.10 A further report will be presented to the Sub-committee once the contract has been awarded.
