

## **Covid-19 Restrictions for Licenced Premises**

### **21 March 2020**

Requiring all restaurants and cafes not to sell food or drink for consuming on the premises and any part of the premises, or part of the premises, in which food or drink are sold for consumption on such premises must be closed.

### **27 March 2020**

Confirmed food delivery and takeaway can remain operational.

### **04 July 2020**

Full reopening of restaurants but table service only.

### **24 September 2020**

10pm closures for pubs and restaurants.

### **23 October 2020**

Manchester in Tier 3, Pubs and restaurants must close unless they serve alcohol only as part of a main meal. The meal must be eaten while seated at a table (not at a serving counter). Still close at 10pm.

### **05 November 2020**

National 'circuit breaker' lockdown, hospitality apart from takeaway must close.

### **02 December 2020**

National lockdown ends, tiers again, Manchester in Tier 4, hospitality same as 05 November 2020.

### **12 April 2021**

Outdoor hospitality venues, including pub gardens, are allowed to open for outdoor sales only, with a maximum of 6 people per party from a maximum of two households.

### **17 May 2021**

Pubs and restaurants open inside.
