Public safety	Please state your reasons: The Manchester Marathon is a planned event which is happening on the 3 <sup>rd</sup> April 2022. Due to the event taking place there are approved road closures which are in place in and around the immediate area to the premises making the application. The Impact of these road closures are such that it will be difficult for vehicles to access Trafford Park road from Manchester/Salford side from 3am on the 3 <sup>rd</sup> April. This event is not due to finish until 6am on the 3 <sup>rd</sup> April. The tram network ceases to run at 12.10am on the 3 <sup>rd</sup> April and does not restart until 6.55am on 3 <sup>rd</sup> April. This means there is no direct route out of the area via public transport during the event and at the end	

	of the event. Whilst Taxis can access via Urmston side, this will severely limit the availability of taxis' and also their willingness to enter the Trafford Park area. This will mean there is a possibility that the public attending the event, would have limited means of safely egressing the industrial park safely and at speed. The finish time of the event also coincides with the start /finish times of the businesses, therefore there may be increased traffic on the roads at this time , and drivers may be further confused about road closures, which will mean that it may not be as safe for pedestrians who are unfamiliar with the area. The applicant has suggested that he can get one taxi firm on board to service the event. I am of the opinion that this will not be enough to assist upto 500 people to leave the event. I am of the opinion that the egress plan has not taken into consideration the impact of the marathon event and the road closures on the ability of the people to egress the event safely.
