Report Title

Barton Road area, Stretford – Proposed Waiting Restrictions

Summary

The Council has been contacted by residents concerned with inconsiderate parking in the limited waiting bays outside the shops on Barton Road and around the junctions in the vicinity leading to congestion and safety issues.

The proposal seeks to introduce new restrictions in the parking bay including making sections of the bay unrestrictive to help with congestion. 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions in the form of junction protection and along the narrow Baslow Road are also proposed to improve pedestrian access and visibility for all road users.

The proposal is shown on drawing number E9133 – Rev B appended to this report.

Recommendations

Agreement is sought for the following:

- 1. That authorisation be given to advertise the intention to introduce the Traffic Regulation Order as detailed in the Schedule to this report and that, if no objections are maintained, the Order be made and implemented in whole or in part, as soon as is practicable.
- 2. That any objections maintained be reported back for consideration.

1.0 BACKGROUND

- 1.1. Problems caused by inconsiderate parking in the limited waiting bays outside the shops on Barton Road have been subject to complaints made by residents to the council. The issues include long-stay parking, preventing customers from accessing the shops and businesses, and parking on footways that causes obstruction and safety issues.
- 1.2. It is considered that the parking bays would benefit from new timings and the surrounding junctions would benefit from the introduction of junction protection, including along the narrow Baslow Road and that their introduction will alleviate the obstructive and hazardous parking currently occurring at these locations.
- 1.3. It is also proposed to mark the existing bus stop within the lay-by as a 24 hour 'Bus Clearway'.
- 1.4 In October 2021 the Council carried out an informal consultation with residents and affected frontages on Barton Road and the surrounding area who all received a consultation letter and plan regarding the scheme; Plan no. E9133 (appended to this report).
- 1.5 Of the 122 letters sent, 14 responses were received, 4 were for the scheme and 7 against with the other 3 respondents didn't specify.
- 1.6 Summary of additional comments:
 - Changing the restrictions on Barton Road and Baslow Road would cause the vehicles to park elsewhere.
 - Parking is at a premium and the restrictions being put in place on Barton Road would make parking more difficult.
 - The restrictions on Barton Road would push traffic onto Matlock Road.
- 1.7 Having regard to these responses the proposal was amended as followed:
 - The proposed limited waiting bay being reduced in length to allow for more unrestricted parking.
 - Further waiting restrictions proposed on Matlock Road at its junction with Buxton Road.
- 1.8 There has been a request for the bus stop to be re-located away from the layby. However, it is felt that retaining the bus stop in the lay-by minimises the potential for congestion on the main carriageway.
- 1.9 It is considered that these proposals, which provides some rationalisation of the existing restrictions, will provide a greater clarity to motorists, provides some 1 hour limited waiting spaces to enable a turnover of parking for businesses, yet retains some unrestricted parking for longer stay purposes and residents.

Councillor Mike Cordingley: This looks good. Does it need further consultation with the businesses just to make sure we're getting the timings right? I'm thinking of the hairdressers and the pet groomers (which I suppose is just another hairdressers really). Is one hr long enough.

3.0 CONCLUSIONS

- 3.1 It is recommended that, in the interest of pedestrian safety and accessibility, and to ensure that adequate visibility is available at junctions, approval is given to advertise the proposed Traffic Regulation Order as detailed in the Schedule.
