Sorry for the delay in replying.

The Hackney Taxi Trade would like a 20% increase in fares.
This reflects the fact the price raise last time was 10% lower than it could have been, plus the unincreased costs involved in the purchase of CAZ compliant vehicles.
Also the recent events in the Ukraine and the rapidly raising fuel costs as a result.

We propose the following
table of fares
(following Traffords present fare table layout)

For a distance is 900 yards (823m) £3.00

For the first 900 yards (823m) £3.00

For each subsequent 144 yards (132m) thereafter or incomplete part thereof 20p

Waiting time

For each period of 1 minute

Or incomplete part thereof 30p

Extra charges for the whole distance

For hiring commencing between 10pm and 5pm

Normal daytime rates 33 1/3

Christmas day, boxing day, New Year's day,

33 1/3 all day.

Soiling charge £30

Additional person as now

We would also like it considered that Bank Holidays should also be charged at 33 1/3 at the discretion of the driver. This can be achieved by allowing the driver the ability to change tariff from tariff 2 to 1 (if the driver doesn't want to chari tariff 2), but still not allowing the driver to change the metre from tariff 1 to 2, this should be automatically changed at the appropriate times/days according to the fare table, (being reset by switching metre off, when the driver has reduced the tariff)

Hope this makes sense
