To prevent public nuisance	Please state your reasons: The application site is in close proximity to a number of	
	residential premises in the immediate vicinity. There is therefore the potential of noise from the external areas of the premises to negatively impact upon the occupants of these noise sensitive premises if appropriate conditions relating to the external areas are not added to the license.	
	The Pollution department has historically been in receipt of noise complaints relating to this and other commercial premises in the area due to the close proximity of the residential premises on Lisson Grove and Millfield Court to the various commercial properties. With reference to 6-10 Victoria Road, controlling the hours of use of the external area has historically helped to control the noise and reduce complaints. It is understood that there was an undertaking by the previous owners not to use the external side area beyond 8pm.	

	The external areas are likely to be most popular during warm summer weather where residents would need to keep their windows open for ventilation and may wish to also enjoy their own external areas. Noise from patrons will increase as they enjoy their visit, characterised by laughter, raised voices and multiple conversations, which can be very intrusive in nature.
	The current noise related conditions for the premises are contained in Annex 3 of the licence (PL000049) and are as follows:
	1. All external doors and windows shall be kept closed when regulated entertainment is being provided except in the event of an emergency or for ingress and egress to the premises
	2. There shall be placed at all exits from the premises in a place where they can be seen and easily read by the public, (or member and their guests) notices requiring customers to leave the premises and the area quietly. (Note, this may also include a reference to vehicles).
	3. No bottles shall be disposed of or collected from the premises between the hours of 9.00pm and 8.00am where such disposal or collection is likely to cause disturbance to local residents.
	A number of conditions have been recommended below <u>in</u> <u>addition to the existing conditions</u> to achieve the licensing objective of the prevention of public nuisance.

In order to achieve the licensing objective of the prevention of public nuisance I would recommend that the following conditions are attached to the licence in addition to the existing conditions contained in Annex 3 of (PL000049):

- Noise from music and associated sources (including DJ's and amplified voices) must not be audible to such an extent that it constitutes a nuisance at any noise sensitive properties.
- Use of external ground floor seating area of the premises shall only be permitted between the hours of 09.00 20:00 hours on any day.
- Use of the first floor elevated external seating area shall only be permitted between the hours of 09.00 and 20.00 on any day.
- The applicant shall submit for approval, prior to the commencement of use, a noise management plan for the external areas. The noise management plan shall be implemented at all times that these areas are in use.
- No amplified music / sound / speakers shall be permitted to any external part of the site.
