Section 3A – The Licensing Objectives

To prevent crime and disorder

Please accept this as a formal objection by Greater Manchester Police to this temporary event application on the grounds of Prevention of Crime and Disorder and the Protection of Public Safety.

The applicant has submitted a Temporary Event Notice application to Trafford Licensing Authority on the 31st of July for an event on Sunday 3rd September between the hours of 1000-1800 with a capacity of 10 people.

The specifics of this application are to allow the applicant to park a mobile bar, namely a horsebox in the loading bay on Westgate roughly 20 meters from the junction with Ashley Road. Ashley Road is being closed as part of the Tour of Britain bike ride.

Trafford Local Authority have a Public Space Protection Order for areas of Trafford. This order covers the village of Hale where this application is for. Part of this order prevents the drinking of alcohol in a public place and focuses on disruption to the public and antisocial behaviour. It was obtained to prevent alcohol related issues / street drinking and allows a Constable or appropriate figure to seize and dispose of alcohol in such a manner as he considers appropriate. A person who fails without reasonable excuse to

	comply with a requirement imposed on them commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine. The granting of the Temporary Event Notice would allow alcohol to be sold from the road directly in open vessels onto the street conflicting with the PSPO in place currently.
Public safety	Please state your reasons: The Temporary Event Notice isn't intended for open public unregulated spaces, as such there is a numbers limit (499) for the number of people combined attending/working at the premises where the Temporary Event is to be held. As this application is for a bar parked on a public road in an open uncontrolled environment there is no process or way to control numbers. The applicant has listed 10 on the application.

I'm aware there are additional issues over Street Trading Licenses / use of a loading bay / littering / highways which I believe will be represented by another Responsible Authority.

The applicant makes mention to a previous TEN for the Kings Coronation, this formed part of a much larger organised community event with closed of street, stewards, security and event management plans to cover the Coronation.

Greater Manchester Police would therefore request that this application is refused.

If the application is granted as it is unlikely there will be any dedicated Police resources to the event and with road closures in place Emergency Response times are affected, I request that the applicant increase his attending numbers to the maximum allowed of 499 and to make sure all drinks are served in plastics and decanted. That staff are vigilant with regards age verification checks and legislation around serving those already intoxicated.
