Good Afternoon

Thank you for your email. In Clare's absence please direct all further communications to me.

It is the responsible authority's view that the conditions that were proposed by them are the minimum that is required. In such circumstances there is no point in a further meeting.

What is required is your client's acquiescence to the conditions that have been put forward and a demonstration that there are documented policies and procedures in place that are capable of complying with those conditions, together with a demonstration that your clients are committed and able to abide by its policies and those conditions.

Sadly, that has not been demonstrated by your proposed amendments to the conditions, your failure to pursue or withdraw your appeal which is now several years old in circumstances where you were unable or unwilling to state what steps you had taken to further that appeal or meet the conditions within the improvement notices and the two further notices of appeal we received this week.

The report to the sub-committee will be finalised by the 10th October 2023. In order to enable the responsible authorities to consider any positive recommendations that they could make to the Licensing Sub-Committee we will need to have your clients agreement, documentation and demonstration of their commitment by no later than 16:00 on Friday 6th October 2023.
