Public safety	Warwick road is one of the main exit routes for people attending the concerts at Emirates Old Trafford. This route remains crowded for upto 2hours after the concert has finished with pedestrians and vehicles trying to leave the area. The junction with warwick road and chester road lights where the public house is situated has been an area of concern and extra resources have been brought in to manage the area and the traffic. Extending the drinking time would encourage people to stay in this area for longer, which would be a risk to the safety of the people leaving the concert as well as persons attending the premises as it would be dfiifcult to implement any crowd management due to the crowds. It would not also be	

	possible for people to queue outside the premises or undergo necessary checks before entering.
