Section 3A – The Licensing Objectives

To prevent public nuisance

Please state your reasons:

The Environmental Protection team have been liaising with the club prior to the submission of this application to agree suitable conditions to achieve the licensing objective of the prevention of public nuisance. The conditions which have been included in the application are as follows:

- Noise from music and associated sources (including DJ's and amplified voices) shall not be audible to such an extent that it constitutes a nuisance at any noise sensitive properties.
- 2. All external doors and windows shall be kept closed after 22.00h when regulated entertainment is being provided inside the premises except in the event of an emergency.
- 3. There shall be placed at all exits from premises in a place where they can be seen and easily read by the public (or member and their guests) notices requiring customers to leave the premises and the area quietly.
- 4. No fireworks or other pyrotechnics shall be used other than with the prior consent of the Licensing Authority (except for Bonfire night).
- 5. Outdoor events relating to films, shall not be permitted outside the following hours: 10.00h to 23.00h on any day.

- 6. Outdoor events relating to the performance of dance shall not be permitted outside the following hours: 18.00h to 22.00h on any day.
- 7. For outdoor areas, regulated entertainment involving live and / or recorded music shall only be played within a temporary building or marquee on the Licensed Premises between the hours of 10:00h to 22:00h on any day apart from 4 days in any calendar year. On not more than 4 days per calendar year, live music shall only be played within a temporary building or marquee between the hours of 10.00 and 22.30h and on the same days recorded music shall only be played within a temporary building or marquee between the hours of 10.00 and 00.30h.
- 8. For the outdoor events involving the provision of regulated entertainment that take place at the premises (including within a temporary building or marquee), the Premises Licence Holder must ensure that a Noise Management Plan (NMP) is submitted to the Licensing Authority for, approval. The NMP would be subject to review in response to any complaints made by residents, and/or concerns raised by the Licensing Authority.

All regulated entertainment under the provisions of the Premises Licence shall be conducted in accordance with the approved NMP, or any subsequent NMP that has been approved in writing by the Licensing Authority.

9. The Premises Licence Holder shall write to residents of streets specified by the Licensing Authority at least 14 days before an event where live / recorded music is to be played within a temporary building or marquee (apart from the annual Bowdon fireworks event), giving pre-event information including but not limited to when sound checks may be conducted, the times of the performance and associated firework displays and a key point of contact hot-line phone number manned at all times during the event.

Any complaints regarding noise received from local residents via the hot-line number or any other channels shall be logged and dealt with by the site manager, who shall put in place any necessary and practicable measures to address the issue.

Although the above conditions were agreed, the applicant was advised that the conditions are based upon the current views relating to this application, and that we would reserve the right to amend them during the consultation process, taking into consideration any representations/concerns raised by residents.

There have been several representations, and the applicant is due to have a meeting with concerned residents on the evening of 27 08 24.

As a result of the proposed meeting, the applicant may consider additional conditions relating to noise/amendment to some of the proposals.

Should this occur, the Environmental Protection team will liaise with the applicant with a view to agreeing anything further.

The representation may be withdrawn upon reaching a suitable agreement.
