Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Annual Report 2023

### **Summary**

The Holiday Activities and Food programme is a government-funded programme that requires all local authorities to deliver a programme of inclusive activities including a hot meal over the school holidays, for children aged 5-16 years.

This report details the activity delivered in Trafford in Easter, Summer and Christmas Holidays 2023 from Trafford's allocation of £694,550. There were 6701 children in receipt of benefits-related free school meals, and 3859 children attended a HAF programme in 2023.
