**Annex 1 – Mandatory Conditions**

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -

- (a) At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises, or
- (b) At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

#### **ADDITIONAL MANDATORY CONDITIONS (28th May 2014)**

3. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.

4. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1 —

- (a) “duty” is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;
- (b) “permitted price” is the price found by applying the formula—

$$P = D + (D \times V)$$

Where —

- (i) P is the permitted price;
  - (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
- and
- (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
- (c) “relevant person” means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence—
- (i) the holder of the premises licence,
  - (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
  - (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;
- (d) “relevant person” means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and



(e) “valued added tax” means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.

5. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.

6. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day (“the first day”) would be different from the permitted price on the next day (“the second day”) as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.

(2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

**ADDITIONAL MANDATORY CONDITIONS (1st October 2014)**

7.(1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.

(3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either :-

- (a) a holographic mark,
- or
- (b) an ultraviolet feature

**Annex 2 – Conditions Consistent with the Operating Schedule**

1. The licence holder shall ensure that CCTV covers the customer and the sale area together with coverage of the outside of the shop front and back at all times.
2. The licence holder shall ensure that CCTV images are retained for a period of one month.
3. The licence holder shall ensure that staff are vigilant in respect of the sale of alcohol to intoxicated customers.
4. The licence holder shall ensure that no underage sale of alcohol takes place and if in doubt ID will be requested.

5. The licence holder shall ensure that the number of customers is restricted to a manageable number.
6. The licence holder shall ensure that notices are displayed in the shop regarding selling alcohol to underage customers.
7. The licence holder shall ensure that all staff are trained in fire fighting equipment.
8. The licence holder shall ensure that fire risk assessments are carried out.
9. The licence holder shall ensure that regular fire alarm testings are carried out.
10. The licence holder shall ensure that the fire escape doors are not blocked.
11. The licence holder shall ensure that telephone numbers for the local fire station, police and ambulance services are displayed.
12. The licence holder shall ensure that proper internal and external lighting is provided.
13. The licence holder shall ensure that violent and anti-social behaviour is prevented.
14. The licence holder shall ensure that no litter or empty cans/bottles are left outside the shop.
15. The licence holder shall ensure that any signs of disturbance be reported to the police immediately.
16. The licence holder shall ensure that staff are trained to deal with difficult customers.
17. The licence holder shall ensure that no excess alcohol is sold to one individual and will also ensure that alcohol is not consumed in the shop.
18. The licence holder shall ensure that staff are trained to deal with any person attempting to purchase alcohol for an underage person.
19. The licence holder shall ensure that a Challenge 25 sign be placed inside the shop.
