### **33. MINUTES**

### **35. APPLICATION FOR THE GRANT OF A HACKNEY CARRIAGE PROPRIETOR'S (VEHICLE) LICENCE IN RESPECT OF A VEHICLE WHICH DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THE COUNCIL'S CURRENT AGE AND/OR EMISSION STANDARDS**

The Head of Regulatory Services submitted a report requesting members to consider an application for the grant of a Hackney Carriage Proprietor's (Vehicle) Licence in respect of a vehicle which does not comply with the Council's current Age and Emission Standards.

The applicant attended the meeting to enable members to give the matter their full consideration.

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The applicant explained why he felt the Sub-Committee should deviate from the Age and Emission Standards and grant a Hackney Carriage Proprietor's (Vehicle) Licence.

The Sub-Committee considered the report and the evidence given at the meeting and concluded that there was sufficient information to deviate from the policy.

RESOLVED: That Mr. M. O's application for a Hackney Carriage Proprietor's (Vehicle) Licence be granted.

**36. APPLICATION FOR THE GRANT OF A NEW PRIVATE HIRE DRIVER'S LICENCE**

**37. APPLICATION FOR THE GRANT OF A BOTH A NEW PRIVATE HIRE DRIVER'S AND A NEW HACKNEY CARRIAGE DRIVER'S LICENCE FOLLOWING THE EXPIRY OF THE PREVIOUS LICENCES**

The Head of Regulatory Services submitted a report requesting members to consider an application for the grant of both a new Private Hire and a new Hackney Carriage driver's licence following the expiry of the previous licences.

The Sub-Committee considered the report and the evidence given at the meeting and concluded that the applicant was a fit and proper person to hold both a Private Hire driver's licence and a Hackney Carriage driver's licence.

RESOLVED –

- (2) That Mr. I.S resits the induction training for taxi drivers within two months from the date of the meeting.
