#### Introduction

An application has been made to this Committee for the transfer of the premises licence currently held by Orang Parto for Canada Grill, 38 Ashley Road, Hale, Cheshire, WA14 2RE – to Mr Davood Mousavi, Flat 13, Suttan Manor, 552 Wilbraham Road, Manchester, M21 9RB (Appendix A).

#### The Premises

- 2. Details of the premises are as follows:-
  - (a) Location: Canada Grill, 38 Ashley Road, Hale, Cheshire, WA14 2RE
  - (b) <u>Description</u>: Take away

## Representations

3. Section 42(6) of the Act provides that where a chief officer of police is satisfied that the exceptional circumstances of the case are such that granting the application would undermine the crime prevention objective, he must give the relevant licensing authority a notice, within 14 days of receiving the application, stating the reasons why he is so satisfied. The Authority has received a notice from Greater Manchester Police within the specified period. (Appendix B).

## Secretary of State's Guidance

The following is an excerpt of points raised in the Secretary of State's Guidance. Copies of the full Guidance will be available at the hearing:

### "Transfers of premises licences

8.97 The 2003 Act provides for any person who may apply for a premises licence, which includes a business, to apply for a premises licence to be transferred to them. Where the application is made in writing, the applicant must give notice of the application to the chief officer of police, and the Home Office (Immigration Enforcement) if the licence authorises the sale of alcohol or provision of late night refreshment. Where it is made electronically via Business Link or the licensing authority's electronic facility, the licensing authority must notify the police no later than the first working day after the application is given. However, the responsibility to notify the DPS remains with the applicant. Otherwise the general guidance on electronic applications set out in paragraphs 8.23 to 8.31 applies.

8.98 In the vast majority of cases, it is expected that a transfer will be a very simple administrative process. Section 43 of the 2003 Act provides a mechanism which allows the transfer to come into immediate interim effect as soon as the licensing authority receives it, until it is formally determined or withdrawn. This is to ensure that there should be no interruption to normal business at the premises. If the police or the Home Office (Immigration Enforcement) raise no objection about the

application, the licensing authority must transfer the licence in accordance with the application, amend the licence accordingly and return it to the new holder.

8.99 In exceptional circumstances where the chief officer of police believes the transfer may undermine the crime prevention objective, the police may object to the transfer. The Home Office (Immigration Enforcement) may object if it considers that granting the transfer would be prejudicial to the prevention of illegal working in licensed premises. Such objections are expected to be rare and arise because the police or Home Office (Immigration Enforcement) have evidence that the business or individuals seeking to hold the licence or business or individuals linked to such persons are involved in crime (or disorder) or employing illegal workers.

8.100 Such objections (and therefore such hearings) should only arise in truly exceptional circumstances. If the licensing authority believes that the police or the Home Office (Immigration Enforcement) are using this mechanism to vet transfer applicants routinely and to seek hearings as a fishing expedition to inquire into applicants' backgrounds, it is expected that it would raise the matter immediately with the chief officer of police or Home Office (Immigration Enforcement).

#### Observations/recommendations

- 5. Where a notice is given under section 42(6) (and not withdrawn) the authority must consider the application and notice and either:
  - 5.1 grant the application; or
  - 5.2 reject the application if it considers it necessary for the promotion of the crime prevention objective to do so.
- 6. The Committee is advised that any findings on any issues of fact should be on the balance of probability and any decision should be based on the individual merits of the application.
- 7. The Committee is also advised that in arriving at its decision it must have regard to relevant provisions of national guidance and the licensing policy statement and that reasons should be given for any departure.
