1. Background

1.1 Premises Licence PL000667 (Appendix B) – for Hale Country Club, Clay Lane, Hale is currently held by Hale Country Club Limited, 47 Clay Lane, Timperley, WA15 7AF.

2. Application for the Grant of a Premises Licence

2.1 On the 18th April 2019 the Licensing Section received an application (**Appendix A**) from Eversheds Sutherland, Solicitors acting for Hale Country Club Limited for the grant of a variation to the existing premises licence.

2.2 The current licence permits the following licensable activities:

Indoors and Outdoors

Playing of recorded music	10.00 to 24.00	Mon to Sun

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2.4 The licence permits licensable activities to take place in the external area marked in yellow on the deposited plan (the perimeter of the football field) on no more than 10 occasions. A colour copy of the plan will be available at the meeting.

2.5 The application is for the variation of the premises licence in respect of outside events in the area outlined in yellow on the premises licence plan (the perimeter of the football field).

2.6 The applicant requests that the licence be varied to read as follows:

- 2.7** The applicant has also requested an amendment to Annex 3, condition 6i which currently reads:

“There would be a maximum of six events per annum (only 2 allowed per calendar month) between the hours of 10:00 and midnight; and a maximum of four further events between the hours of 10:00 and 19:00.”

The new condition to read:

“There shall be a maximum of two events per annum between the hours of 10:00 and midnight; a maximum of two further events per annum between the hours of 10:00 and 01:00; and a maximum of four further events between the hours of 10:00 and 19:00. Only two outside events finishing after 19:00 shall be allowed per calendar month.”

- 2.8** The applicant has complied with all requirements under the application process including advertising the application in a newspaper, advertising by way of public notice at the premises and submitting a copy of the complete application to all Responsible Authorities. The application is deemed to be correctly submitted.

3. Representations

- 3.1** On the 15th May 2019 the Licensing Section received a representation against the application from the Council's Environmental Pollution Team on the grounds of prevention of public nuisance. See attached Appendix C1.
- 3.2** On the 16th May 2019 the Licensing section received an email objection from a local resident on the grounds of prevention of public nuisance. The same resident then sent a written letter received on the 20th May 2019 which

referred to the noise from an event the previous week. See attached Appendix C2.

4. Licensing Policy and Guidance

- 4.1** The Committee are respectfully referred to the Council's own Licensing Policy relating to the Licensing Act 2003 objectives and to the Secretary of State's Guidance. (Copy available at meeting)

5. Options

- 5.1** The Sub-Committee to take such steps as they consider necessary for the promotion of the Licensing Objectives in accordance with the provisions of subsection 18 (4) of the Licensing Act 2003. The steps specified are:

5.1.1 To grant the licence subject to-

- Conditions consistent with the operating schedule accompanying the application modified to such extent as the authority considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives, and;
- Any mandatory conditions which must be included under the Licensing Act 2003

5.1.2 to exclude from the scope of the licence any of the licensable activities to which the application relates;

5.1.3 to refuse to specify a person in the licence as the premises supervisor;

5.1.4 to reject the application.

- 5.2** The Sub-Committee is advised that any findings on any issues of fact should be on the balance of probability and any decision should be based on the individual merits of the application.

- 5.3** The Sub-Committee, in arriving at its decision, must have regard to relevant provisions of national guidance and its own statement of licensing policy, and reasons should be given for any departure.

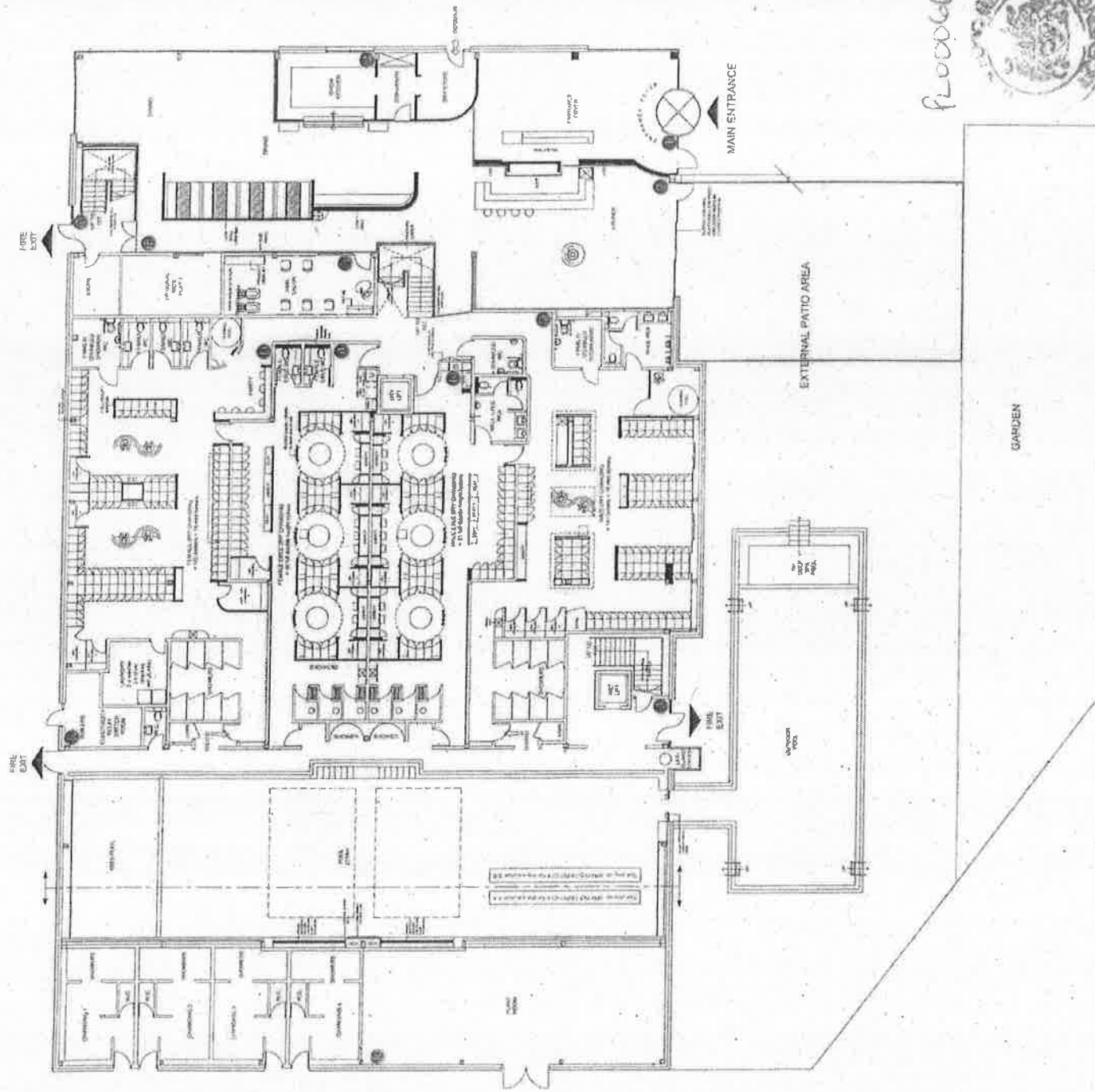

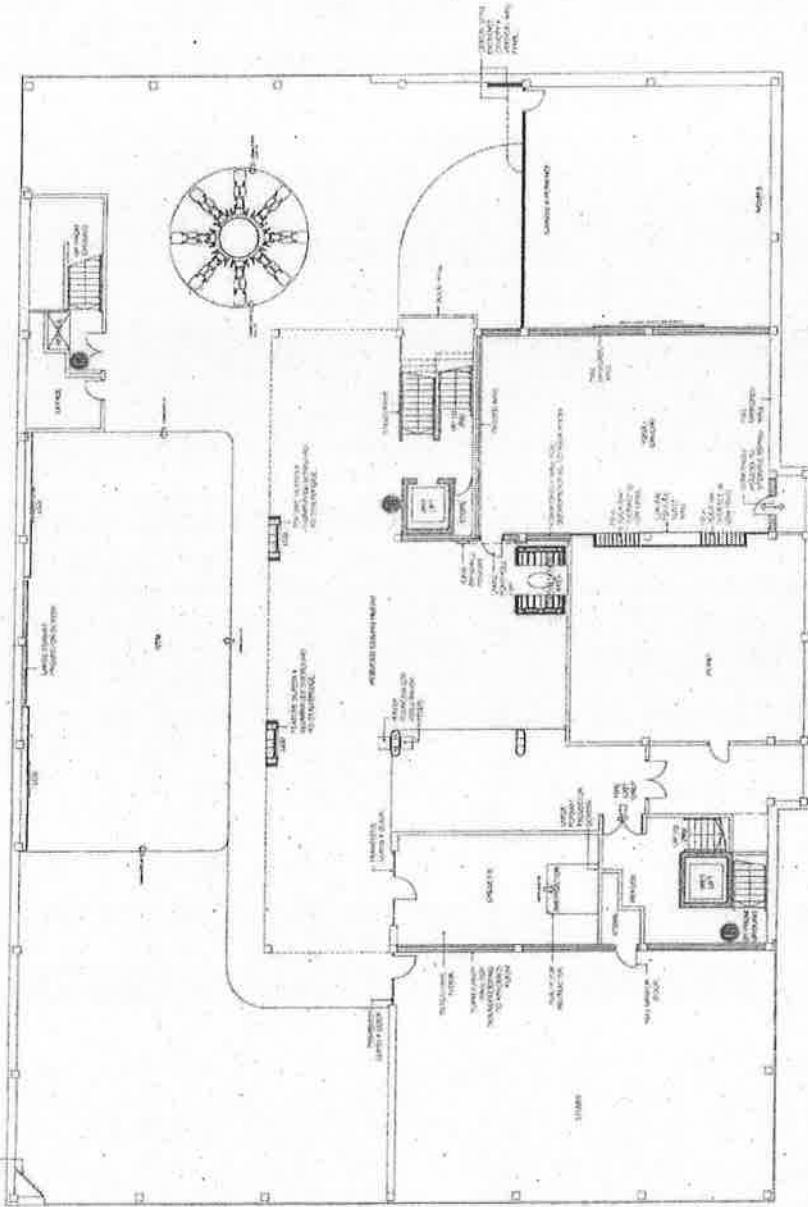

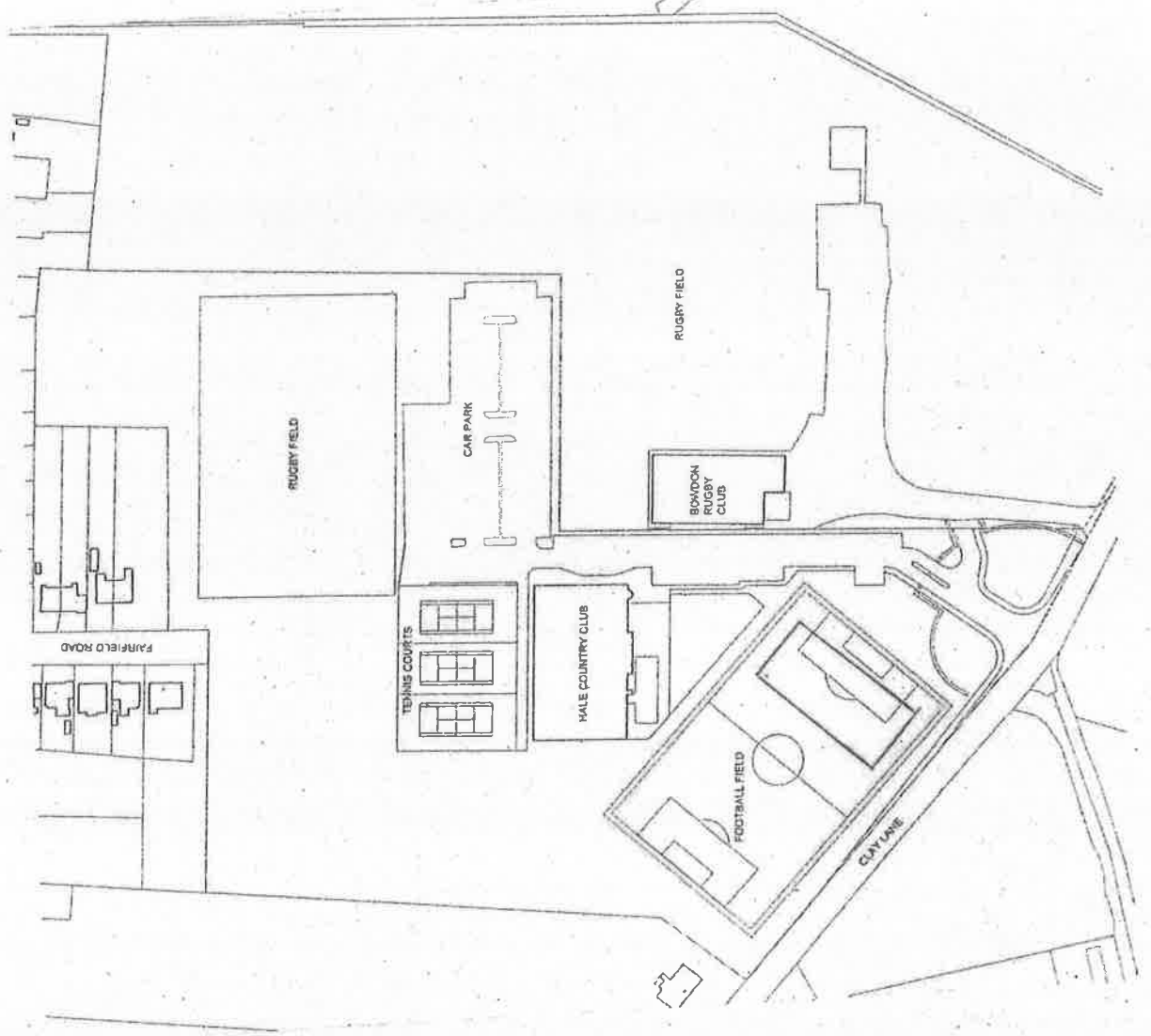

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:
 - (a) At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises, or
 - (b) At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
3. Where a premises licence authorises the exhibition of films, the licence must include a condition requiring the admission of children to the exhibition of any film to be restricted in accordance with this section.
4. Where the film classification body is specified in the licence, unless subsection (3)(b) applies, admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by that body.
5. Where
 - (a) the film classification body is not specified in the licence, or
 - (b) the relevant licensing authority has notified the holder of the licence that this subsection applies to the film in question

Admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by that licensing authority.

6. In this section

"children" means persons aged under 18;
and

"film classification body" means the person or persons designated as the authority under section 4 of the Video Recordings Act 1984 (c.39) (authority to determine suitability of video works for classification).

7. Where the premises licence includes a condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity, each such individual
