Annex 1 – Mandatory Conditions

#### MANDATORY CONDITIONS

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:
  - (a) At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises, or
  - (b) At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended
2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

#### ADDITIONAL MANDATORY CONDITIONS (28<sup>th</sup> May 2014)

3. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
4. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1
  - (a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979
  - (b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula

$$P = D + (D \times V)$$

Where

- (i) P is the permitted price
- (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol

and

- (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol
- (c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence
- (i) the holder of the premises licence
  - (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
  - (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence
- (d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
- (e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.
5. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
6. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.
- (2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

### **ADDITIONAL MANDATORY CONDITIONS (1<sup>st</sup> October 2014)**

7. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- (2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must

ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.

(3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either :-

- (a) a holographic mark,
- or
- (b) an ultraviolet feature

### Annex 2 – Conditions Consistent with the Operating Schedule

1. The licence holder shall ensure that a CCTV system will be in operation at the premises and recorded images shall be retained for a period of 30 days.
2. The licence holder shall ensure that the data will be made available to the Police and Authorised Officers of the Council upon reasonable request.
3. The licence holder shall ensure that a register of refusals of alcohol will be maintained at the premises.
4. The register shall be examined on a regular basis by the duty Manager/DPS and the date and time of each examination will be endorsed in the register.
5. The licence holder shall ensure that the register will be made available for inspection by the Police and other Authorised Officers of the Council upon reasonable request.
6. The licence holder shall ensure that the premises adopt a 'Challenge 25' policy. This means that if a customer purchasing alcohol appears to be under the age of 25, they will be asked for proof of their age, to prove that they are 18 years or older.
7. The licence holder shall ensure that posters will be on display advising customers of the 'Challenge 25' policy.
8. The licence holder shall ensure that the only forms of identification that will be accepted at the premises are a Passport, Photo-Card Driving Licence & Cards bearing the PASS hologram.
