In the past two months we have:

- Agreed delivery schedule, ways of working and Board expectations on reform areas
- Agreed place based meetings and development sessions
- Partner System Learning with Wigan
- Each pillar and enabler SRO has a delivery slot, providing constructive system challenge and accountability for delivery
- January - Prevention and Social Value presented, LCA partners have pledged commitment to aims and delivery goals - action immediately evident
- February - primary care, workforce and digital links, Planned and Urgent Care being presented
- LCO programme development built on the 6 pillars
- Neighbourhood plans being developed (Public Health, LCO, PCNs)

In the last 2 months working with wider system partners we have -

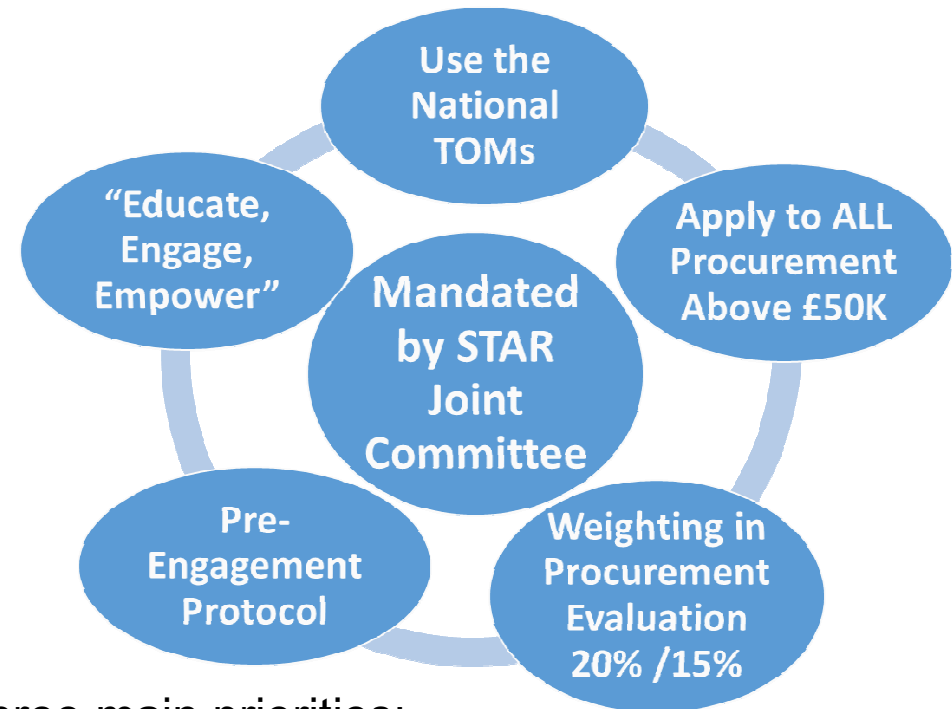
- Moved into delivery stage SRO representation for each of the pillars and enablers, feeds into the LCA delivery programme for better distributed system leadership
- Place Directorate actively involved through senior leadership
- System performance workshop held, development of a system level performance and outcomes dashboard (March LCA item)
- System wide engagement and communications steering group established - endorsement from the VCSE sector (2 forums held), and commitment to help drive the year's engagement approach – lunch and learn sessions being scheduled (March LCA item)
- Living Well At Home Board Established (Manchester and Trafford System )
- Finance colleagues setting up a finance reform group
- Enabler and reform leads developing matrix working across areas

# Our Commitment: Primary Care

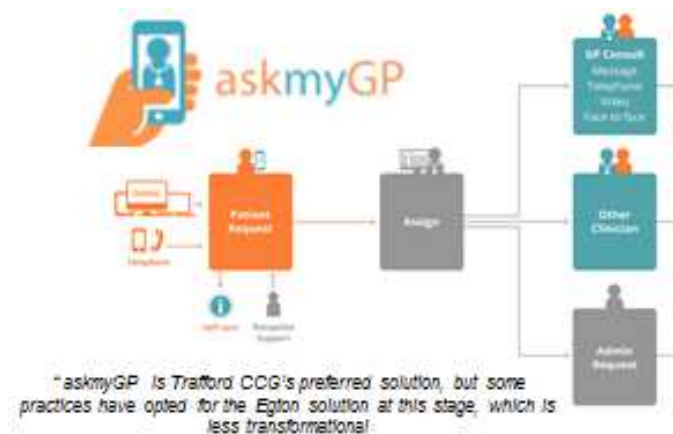

NHSE are promoting and partially funding a simplified patient journey utilising three digital elements which compliment existing solutions such as NHS.UK and the NHS App:

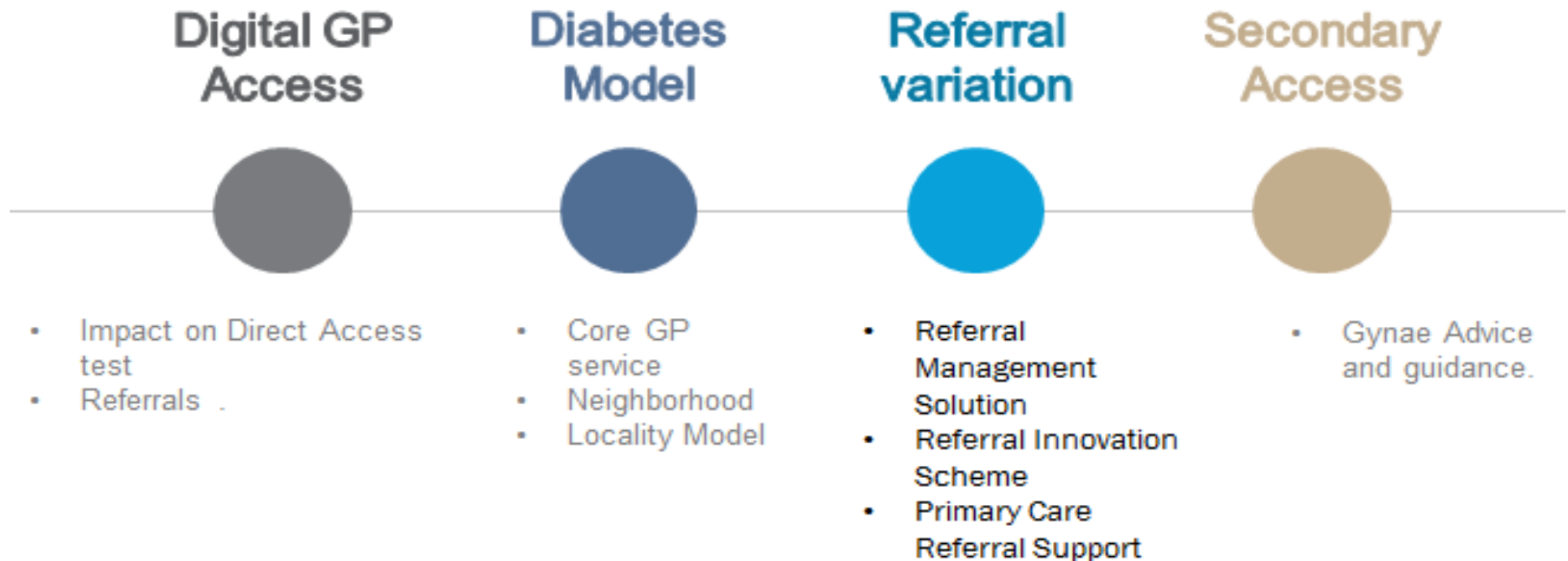
- Questionnaire based consultations
