Priority groups have been identified: university students, NHS staff and people living or working in high risk settings; To note that testing is still available for symptomatic people who can attend existing testing sites; people awaiting for test results need to self-isolate; To note that mass testing for community staff has started, district nurses and palliative care nurses will test twice a week for 12 weeks; To note that antibody testing will be available for members of staff working in Adult Social Care; details of the web-site with relevant information will be circulated.
