In considering whether a user has breached our social media guidelines we will monitor our channels and adopt the following protocols:

Moderating content

- We will delete a comment if it is abusive, offensive and/or contains expletives. If an individual continues to behave in this manner they will be blocked
- We will ban a user when they are abusive, offensive or insult a member of staff, an elected member or another user on one or more occasions
- We will remove content copied from elsewhere, for which you do not own the copyright
- We will remove post that publicise an individual's personal information, such as contact details
