#### 1. Application for the Grant of a Premises Licence.

- 1.1 On the 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2015 the Licensing Section received an application from Urmston Men's Club & Institute, for the grant of a premises licence for Urmston Men's Club & Institute, 82 High Road, Urmston. (**Appendix A**).
- 1.2 The application requested the granting of a premises licence to provide sale of alcohol (on & off) the premises, late night refreshment and regulated entertainment.
- 1.3 The hours requested for the licensable activities on the original application are as follows:

<u>Sale of Alcohol</u> (on & off premises): Monday to Sunday – 10:00 to 00:00

<u>Late Night Refreshment</u> (Indoors): Monday to Sunday – 23:00 to 00:00

<u>Provision of Regulated Entertainment</u> (plays; films; indoor sports; boxing or wrestling, live music; recorded music; and performance of dance):

Monday to Sunday - 10:00 to 00:00

1.4 The applicant has complied with all requirements under the application process including advertising the application in a newspaper, advertising by way of public notice at the premises and submitting a copy of the complete application to all Responsible Authorities. The application is deemed to be correctly submitted.

#### 2. Representations

- 2.1 During the consultation period, a representation was received from the Council's Pollution Section (**Appendix B**).
- 2.2 The recommended conditions have been agreed by the applicant and will form part of the proposed conditions to be attached to the premises licence (**Appendix B**).

#### 3. Options

The Members are invited to consider the representation and the agreement given by the applicant and either:

- Agree that a hearing is not necessary and determine to grant the licence subject to the conditions being attached; or
  - Agree that a hearing is necessary with all the parties present.

M Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

#### a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 9)

All licensing activites permitted by this Premises Licence will only be carried out on pre-booked functions. Customers entering and exiting the front of the premises will be monited by staff.

CCTV has been installed at the premises to cover customer areas. The equipment will be mainted to the standard of the Gtr. Manchester Police Policy. All images to be retained for a minimum of 31 days. The premises are alarmed when closed.

#### b) The prevention of crime and disorder

When the DPS is not on duty a contact telephone number will be available at all times.

Records of incidents will be recorded in an **Incident log** and retained on the premises for 12 months. The premises will operate and record all Incidents of criminal activities, anti-social behaviour and injuries to persons using the following Compliance log books **Customer Refusal**, **Authorisation of Alcohol**, **ID Signature** to assist the police and authorities in carrying out their investigations. All log books are fit for purpose and will be retained on the premises for 12 months.

#### c) Public safety

The maximum capacity of the Concert Room shall not exceed 250 person. No further risk has been assessed under the Licensing Act 2003

#### d) The prevention of public nuisance

A risk assessment shall be conducted when live or recorded music is being played, to assess the noise levels at the nearest residential/noise sensitive premises at the rear of the premises. Remedial action to be taken if necessary to reduce noise levels and to ensure residential premises will not be adversely affected. All assessments to be recorded in a **Noise assessment** log book.

#### e) The protection of children from harm

All children under the age of 18 will be accompanied by a responsible adult. A "Challenge 21" policy shall be operated at the premises at all times.

The only forms of ID that shall be accepted (at the discretion of the Management) as proof of age are a valid passport, a valid photographic driving licence, a PASS approved proof of age card, HM Services Warrant Card or other reliable photo I.D. that is approved for acceptance by the Police or other Authorised Officers. Publicity materials notifying customers of the operation of the "Challenge 21" scheme shall be displayed at the premises. The Designated Premises Supervisor or Premises Licence Holder shall operate and maintain an up-to-date Register of Refusals of Sale of Alcohol, indicating the date, time and reason for refusal which shall be made available for inspection by Trading Standards, Licensing Authority Officers and the Police. Alternatively an electronic point of sale refusals log shall be kept. A documented training programme shall be introduced for all staff in a position to sell, serve or deliver alcohol. The programme shall be made available for inspection at the request of Trading Standards, Licensing Authority Officers and Police. The DPS or Premises Licence Holder shall conduct six monthly reviews with all members of staff authorised to sell alcohol in order to reinforce the training and to promote best practice. A written record shall be kept of the content of such reviews.



# AGREED ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS TO BE INCLUDED ON LICENCE

#### PPN3

"Noise from music and associated sources( including DJ's and amplified voices) must not be audible to such an extent that it constitutes a nuisance <u>at</u> any noise sensitive properties".

#### PPN4

All external doors and windows shall be kept closed when regulated entertainment is being provided except in the event of an emergency.

#### PPN6

There shall be placed at all exits from the premises in a place where they can be seen and easily read by the public, (or member and their guests) notices requiring customers to leave the premises and the area quietly. (Note, this may also include a reference to vehicles).
