1. Application for the Grant of a Premises Licence.

- On the 22nd May, 2015 the Licensing Section received an application from London Midland Railway Club Association, for the grant of a premises licence for London Midland Railway Club Association, 127 Navigation Road, Timperley, Altrincham. (**Appendix A**).
- 1.2 The application requested the granting of a premises licence to provide sale of alcohol (on & off) the premises, late night refreshment and regulated entertainment.
- 1.3 The hours requested for the licensable activities on the original application are as follows:

Sale of Alcohol (on & off premises): Monday to Sunday – 10:00 to 02:00

<u>Late Night Refreshment</u> (indoors & outdoors): Monday to Sunday – 23:00 to 02:00

<u>Provision of Regulated Entertainment</u> (plays; films; indoor sports; boxing or wrestling, live music; recorded music; and performance of dance):

Monday to Sunday - 11:00 to 02:00

1.4 The applicant has complied with all requirements under the application process including advertising the application in a newspaper, advertising by way of public notice at the premises and submitting a copy of the complete application to all Responsible Authorities. The application is deemed to be correctly submitted.


2. Representations




