### 1. Background

- 1.1 The premises known as Trafford Metrovics Sports Club is situated at MacPherson Park at the end of Finney Bank Road in Sale and currently benefits from a Club Premises Certificate CP000041 (Appendix A).
- 1.2 Club Premises Certificate CP000041 was first granted under grandfather rights through conversion in November 2005 and is evidenced at **Appendix A**.

### 2. Application for the Grant of a Variation to a Club Premises Certificate.

- 2.1 On 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2015, the Licensing Section received an application from Mr Christopher Higgins as Club Secretary on behalf of Trafford MVRFCC Sports Club, for the variation to the existing Club Premises Certificate. (**Appendix A**).
- 2.2 The application seeks to reduce the terminal hour of licensable activities.
- 2.3 The application seeks to add additional areas to the building known as the club house following recent Planning approval from Planning and Building Control and will include the use of the patio area as "on" premises for the purposes of consumption of alcohol.
- 2.4 The patio area, as shown in yellow on the attached plan, **(Appendix B)** is to be considered as the beer garden for the club house in respect of the condition relating to use and terminal hour as granted under Annex 3 of the existing licence.
- 2.5 Further, the application seeks to increase the licensed layout to the perimeter of the Clubs grounds to allow members and guests to consume alcohol whilst spectating at matches and competitions.
- 2.6 The applicant has complied with all requirements under the application process including advertising the application in a newspaper, advertising by way of public notice at the premises and submitting a copy of the complete application to all Responsible Authorities.
- 2.7 The application is deemed to be correctly submitted.

### 3. Representations

- 3.1 On 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2015 a representation was received from Rachael Hall, Environmental Health Officer for Trafford Council Regulatory Services, Environmental Health, Pollution, Housing and Licensing Section. (**Appendix C**).
  - 3.1.1. The representation requests the inclusion of additional noise and nuisance conditions :

- Noise from music and associated sources (including DJ's and amplified voices) from within the premises must not be audible to such an extent that it constitutes a nuisance <u>at</u> any noise sensitive property.
- 2. The licence holder or his representative shall conduct regular assessments of the noise emanating from the premises on every occasion the premises are used for regulated entertainment and shall take steps to reduce the level of noise where it is likely to cause disturbance to local residents.
- 3.1.2. The representation further requests that the pitch and outdoor field area are conditioned in respect of the consumption of alcohol.
  - 1. The external field and pitch area shall be restricted to match events only and the consumption of alcohol will cease at 19.30 hours.
- 3.2 The Licensing Section has received from the applicant an agreement to the inclusion of the conditions and use of the external pitch and field area and the applicants confirmation that a full hearing is not necessary. (Appendix D).

## 4. Options

The Members are invited to consider the representation and the agreement given by the applicant and either:

- Agree that a hearing is not necessary and determine to grant the licence subject to the conditions being attached; or
- Agree that a hearing is necessary with all the parties present.

#### Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours.

Permitted Hours Means those stated on the licence and as follows:

 On New Year's Eve from the end of licensing hours on New Year's Eve to the start of licensing hours on the following day (or, if there are no licensing hours on the following day, midnight on 31<sup>st</sup> December)

2. On Christmas Day, as provided by the rules of the club and notified in writing by the Chairman or Secretary of the club to the Licensing Authority in which the premises are. The said hours shall:

- Not exceed six and a half hours
- Not begin earlier than twelve noon
- Not end later than 10.30 pm
- Provide for a break of at least two hours, including 3 pm to 5 pm
- Not extend for more than three and half hours after 5 pm.
- Where the premises licence includes a condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity, each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.





## Hi Jan,

I understand from your email below that the club's intention in submitting this application is to enable spectators to consume alcohol outdoors whilst watching a match; however, in granting their application in its current form, this would enable members and visitors to consume alcohol outdoors - whether there is a match on or not - in accordance with the hours stated in the application, these being:

0700-2330 Mon-Fri 0700-0030 Saturday 0700-2300 Sunday

Given the close proximity of residential dwellings, I would be reluctant to approve this.

I note that Annexe 3 of CP0041 contains a condition which prohibits use of beer gardens or outside areas beyond 2100hrs or dusk (whichever is sooner). I am not aware that there is a beer garden currently in existence?

As an alternative way forward, I would be happy to condition any approval for variation by restricting the consumption of alcohol outdoors to occasions where matches are being played.

Suggested conditions for inclusion:

- Use of the outdoor area for the consumption of alcohol (as outlined in the plan submitted with the application for variation) shall be restricted to match events only and will cease at 1930hours. (NB. This does not permit the playing of amplified music /voices, live music or recorded music to outdoors, at any time.)
- 2. Noise from music and associated sources (including DJ's and amplified voices) from within the premises must not be audible to such an extent that it constitutes a nuisance <u>at</u> any noise sensitive property.
- 3. All external doors and windows shall be kept closed when regulated entertainment is being provided except in the event of an emergency.

- 4. The licence holder or his representative shall conduct regular assessments of the noise emanating from the premises on every occasion the premises are used for regulated entertainment and shall take steps to reduce the level of noise where it is likely to cause disturbance to local residents.
- 5. There shall be placed at all exits from the premises in a place where they can be seen and easily read by the member and their guests, notices requiring customers to leave the premises and the area quietly.

 Use of the pitch and field outdoor area for the consumption of alcohol (as outlined on the plan below) shall be restricted to match events only and will cease at 1930hours. (NB. This does not permit the playing of amplified music /voices, live music or recorded music to outdoors, at any time.)
